Booking Policies and Rules

Booking Policies

- Sleepovers are limited to children ages 5 to 12 years old. Children must be accompanied by an adult (age 21+) with a ratio of 1 registered adult for every 4 children.
- Registration will close at least 1 week prior to the Sleepover date. Reservations are required; no walk-ins will be admitted.
- Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Executed Consent Forms are due at online booking for individuals and groups. Guests may be denied admission to the event without an Executed Consent Form.
- Sleeping arrangements are assigned by the Museum based on the capacities of the event venue. A request to sleep together may be made at time of booking, but fulfillment is not guaranteed.

Sleepover Rules

- Check-in begins at 6:30 pm and closes at 8:00 pm. No entry to the event will be permitted after 8:00 pm.
- All belongings must be removed from the Museum by 9:00 am the morning following the Sleepover.
- Due to the sensitivity of our collections, no outside food or drink is permitted inside the Museum. Water bottles are permitted, but may only be consumed in designated approved areas. For any dietary requirements or restrictions, please contact sleepovers@nhm.org before booking.
- Alcohol and drugs are not permitted. Anyone found to be in possession of or under the influence of these substances will be asked to leave immediately and will not receive a refund.
- No smoking is allowed anywhere on property. Anyone found to be smoking will be asked to leave immediately and will not receive a refund.
- Shoes must be worn at all times inside the Museum and may only be removed to sleep.
- Adults and chaperones must take responsibility for supervising children and adhering to all Museum rules.
- The Museum's staff is committed to making the evening a fun experience for everyone. Please help us maintain a safe environment for guests and our collections by picking up after yourself, respecting the rules of the Museum, and keeping an eye on the children in your group. If you see something, please say something.
