PARKING

Parking for personal vehicles and vans is available for \$12 in the NHM Car Park on Bill Robertson Lane off of Exposition Blvd. If the Car Park is full, you will be directed to the California Science Center visitor parking structure, which is also \$12. REGISTRATION & ADMISSION

REGISTRATION IS NOT REQUIRED. Admission is free for all those participating in the event. Tickets for special Homeschool Day programs with limited availability will be distributed on a first-come, first serve basis at check-in. CHECK-IN

Beginning at 9:30am, check in at any admissions kiosk to receive free General Admission to the Museum. After you've checked in, visit our Welcome Table in the Grand Foyer where you can pick up a schedule of the day's activities and free timed tickets for any special programs (limited availability). Once you have checked in and received a museum sticker, you can come in and out of the museum all day.

Homeschool groups and families receive free museum admission all day, however, special Homeschool Day programming is only scheduled between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm.

LUNCH & SNACK

Unfortunately, there is no lunch storage inside the museum. You may bring a lunch safely secured in a backpack, however, we ask that all food (except water and baby formula) be consumed outside, under the trees on the grass in front of the Museum or on the picnic benches overlooking the Rose Garden adjacent to the Museum.
