

Make Ink Lemonade

This black lemonade recipe was inspired by our favorite cephalopod, Squidward! Cephalopods are a group of ocean animals that are part of the mollusk family that typically have a large head and a set of tentacles. In the wild, cephalopods release their slimy ink as a form of protection against predators. In an episode of Spongebob, we see Squidward release ink when he gets scared by Patrick which is a perfect example of ink being released in action.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED



White sugar or sugar substitute

3 cups of water

**1 cup of lemon juice
(powdered lemonade mix can be used instead)**

Ice

Black food coloring

Pitcher

Mixing spoon

Measuring cups



STEP 1

Cut and juice your lemons.
Depending on size, 4–6 lemons
should make 1 cup of lemon juice.
Pour lemon juice into the pitcher



STEP 2

Pour the water into the pitcher



STEP 3

Pour in 1 cup of sugar,
or add to taste



STEP 4

Mix well



STEP 5

Add 3–4 drops of food dye and mix



STEP 6

Pour lemonade in cups with ice and enjoy while watching the episode that inspired this recipe!
