Series and Arrangement Note:

The collection is organized into three series:

- Series 1. Printed, loose issue newspapers housed in the Seaver Center repository, 1690 – 1982, undated (bulk is 1770-1948)
- Series 2. Bound volumes and microfilmed newspapers housed in the Seaver Center repository, 1851 – 1999, undated
- Series 3. Printed newspapers housed in the Research Library, 1690 – 20th century

Scope and Content:

An artificial collection of American newspapers published in the English language. Also American-published papers of southern California in other languages. One of the strengths of the collection is its southern California and Los Angeles area papers. Also some foreign newspapers. 1690 – 1999, undated.

The collection is housed in two locations:

1. The Seaver Center repository has scattered, incomplete runs, or bound volumes, particularly rare issues for Los Angeles city and county, including the Los Angeles Star. Also noteworthy in the collection are two issues (1888) of the first Black newspaper from southern California, called the Weekly Observer.

The Center also houses a microfilm collection of historic newspapers of Los Angeles and southern California. Many of these reels are microfilm copies of print issues housed in the Research Library.

2. The Research Library houses most of the print issues of the Museum's newspapers. For holdings, visit the California Newspaper Project website: <http://cnp.ucr.edu/> and search their Public Access Public Newspaper Catalog on the institution field "LA Natural History Museum".

Series 1. Printed, loose issue newspapers housed in the Seaver Center repository, 1690 – 1982, undated (bulk is 1770-1948)

This series contain printed scattered issues, incomplete runs, historical headline issues, and commemorative reprints (i.e. historical reprints by the Evening Outlook from Santa Monica, California published in 1976). The container list contains non-English Los Angeles area newspapers, but this series container list currently does not list foreign newspapers. Exceptions: a single issue of the Honolulu Star-Bulletin (1935) is filed under United States in box 19; box 22 contains World War II era army newspapers.
