*Chain Fern:* I'm sensitive to the sun, so I live in cool and shady spots. Look for me underneath the bridge.

*Sycamore:* My large leaves cover the ground in the winter, making safe homes for little critters like bugs. Look for my leaves on the path.

*Toyon:* Birds love to eat my red berries, which only grow in the winter. **Look for me by the Dry Creek Bed.** 

*Spiderweb:* I can come in all different shapes and sizes depending on which spider made me. Look for me in nooks and crannies and on plants.

White Sage: My leaves and stems are used for food, medicine, and ceremonies by some of the Native American peoples in California. Look for me in a sunny spot between the Pond and the Museum.

*Fox Squirrel:* Even though I live near humans, natural foods like acorns and berries are my favorite. Look for me climbing trees.

*Maidenhair Fern:* I like to get my feet wet by splashing around near the water. Look for me in the Pond.

*White Alder:* Instead of growing fruit, I make catkins! Can you find any growing on my branches? **Look for me standing along the path.** 

*Bee Hotel:* I'm a safe space for native bees to raise their young. Look for me by the Pollinator Meadow.
